

PENNSYLVANIA'S FOUNDATIONS: A BRIEF OVERVIEW

Over 60,000 grant-making foundations in the United States hold about \$480 Billion in assets according to *The Foundation Directory* (2002 Edition) and annually award over \$27 Billion in grants. About one-third of this philanthropic wealth is held by foundations in six mid-Atlantic states—New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Delaware, Maryland, and the District of Columbia.

Foundation Assets in Pennsylvania

As the keystone state of this “foundation belt,” Pennsylvania hosts a diverse foundation community with assets exceeding \$24.8 Billion (2000 or 2001 data). This places Pennsylvania as the nation’s #4 Foundation State, behind New York (\$83 Billion), California (\$64 Billion), Washington State (\$27 Billion) and ahead of Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, and Texas (all around \$20 Billion).

The Commonwealth’s 100 largest foundations account for 82% of the state’s foundation wealth and, indeed, just the largest dozen foundations comprise 57% of total assets! Table V (pp. viii-x) lists Pennsylvania’s top 214 foundations—those with assets over \$15 Million *and/or* awarding \$750,000 or more in grants, listed by *descending assets*. Table VI (pp. xi-xiii) lists these same foundations by *descending grant totals*. At the other/lower end of the assets spectrum are 1,400 smaller foundations whose assets comprise only 11.7% of the total.

The bulk of Pennsylvania’s foundation wealth is concentrated in the highly urbanized and industrialized Southwestern (SW) and Southeastern (SE) regions (see map below) centering on Pittsburgh and Philadelphia, respectively. Together the SW and SE regions account for 91.6% of the state’s foundation assets even though only 56.3% of Pennsylvanians reside in the 19 counties comprising these regions.

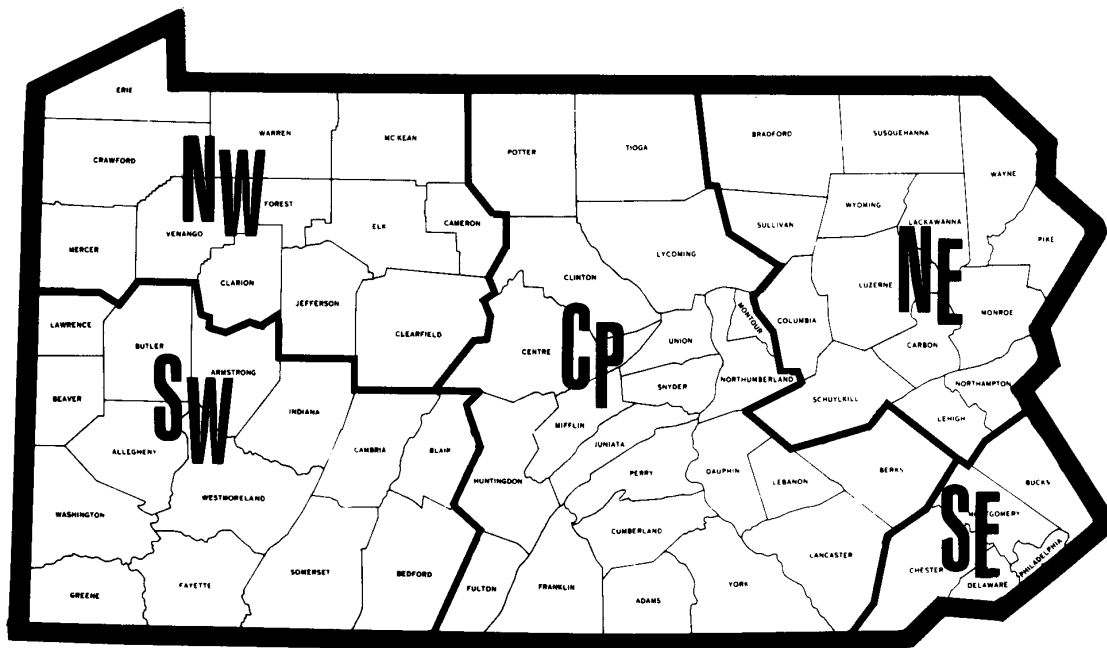


Table I (next page) details the regional distribution of assets of foundations profiled in the 7th Edition which account for nearly all discretionary giving by Pennsylvania foundations.

Foundation Definition and Criteria for Inclusion

For a foundation to be profiled in the 7th Edition it had to meet two fiscal criteria based on the foundation's most recent year of record (2001 or 2000 with few exceptions):

- **Assets at Market Value were \$250,000 or more, and/or**
- **Total grant support exceeded \$10,000**

In addition, a foundation had to meet (in most cases) The Foundation Center's definition of a Private Foundation:

...a nongovernmental, nonprofit organization, with funds (usually from a single source, either an individual, a family or corporation) and program managed by its own trustees or directors, and established to maintain or aid social, educational, charitable, religious, or other activities serving the common welfare, primarily through the making of grants. Charitable trusts are included as well as community foundations (which receive funds from many sources).

Profile-entries were **not** prepared for the following: (1) private operating foundations which administer their own programs directly and generally make no discretionary grants; (2) charitable organizations which bear the name "Foundation" but whose primary purpose is not awarding grants; and, (3) charitable trusts, typically managed by a bank trust department, which restrict grants—generally under the terms of a Will or Trust Instrument—grants to designated beneficiary institutions or to a narrowly defined group of beneficiaries.

Grant Support by Pennsylvania Foundations

The 7th Edition's 1,614 profiled foundations awarded over 80,000 grants totaling over \$1.51 Billion, representing a payout rate of 6.0% on the foundations' aggregated assets. Table III details the regional spread of grant support and grant-dollars per capita.

It is estimated that about three-fourths of the Pennsylvania's top 214 foundations (see Table VI on the following pages) awarded at least \$500,000 in grants to organizations or institutions *within* the Commonwealth. An estimated 70% of all grant support by Pennsylvania foundations goes to Pennsylvania organizations or institutions, yet there are notable variances in regional giving. Foundations in the CP, NE and NW regions likely award over 90% of their support to Pennsylvania, whereas the figure for the SE and SW regions is about two-thirds, largely because of significant, nationwide giving by Pittsburgh-based corporate foundations, or nationally-oriented foundations such as Philadelphia's Pew Charitable Trusts and The Annenberg Foundation.

Non-Profiled Foundations

Table IV below details the categories of 2,100+ Pennsylvania foundations or charitable trusts which did **not** meet the criteria to be profiled in the 7th Edition. For grantseekers, the 371 foundations classified as "Limited Assets/Giving" (generally assets under \$250,000 and \$10,000 or less in discretionary grants) may be of possible interest. Definitions of Non-Profiled Foundation categories can be found in the *User's Guide to the Directory* chapter.
